



SCHOOL GROUP RULES

Thank you for choosing to visit the Battleship NORTH CAROLINA! We look forward to welcoming you!

Payment:

The Battleship only accepts debit/credit cards as payment at the Ticket Counter and in the Store.

Business checks will be accepted for group payments at the Ticket Counter.

Arrival Information:

When you arrive, the lead teacher should check-in at the Ticket Counter. Additional teachers/chaperones will also need to check-in and pay at the Ticket counter. Students should remain on the bus until they can enter the Visitor Center as a group. Restrooms are in the Visitor Center and alongside the building.

Student Conduct:

- Remind your students that the Battleship North Carolina is a Memorial, National Historic Landmark and a museum containing irreplaceable artifacts.
- Students need to always stay with their teachers and/or chaperones.
- Running, jumping, shouting, rough-housing and throwing materials are not permitted.

Ship Store:

- Students may enter the Ship Store by groups of 10 students + 1 adult.
- A sequencing of groups may be arranged with a Store Supervisor to help your group remain on schedule.
- Purchases must stay inside your bag until you leave the Store.
- Shoplifting is illegal and will not be tolerated.

School Group Safety & Behavior Briefing

TEACHERS: On the day of your visit, please read this School Group Safety & Behavior Briefing to your group (including chaperones) before they enter the Visitor Center and begin their tour.

- **SUPERVISION:** Students must always remain under the control of a teacher/chaperone. Teachers/chaperones must quickly address foul play, yelling, running or other behavior that is not appropriate. Teachers/chaperones must quickly address foul play, yelling, running or other behavior that is not appropriate.
- **SAFETY:** All visitors must always remain on the tour route. No running, skipping, jumping or climbing. Use each step on the ship ladders and always hold on with both hands. Keep your eyes on the path in front of you.

- **BEHAVIOR:** Students who misbehave will receive one warning from the Battleship staff. If they continue to misbehave or show disrespect to the staff, they will be asked to leave the Battleship and return to the bus. The Battleship is a Memorial and not a playground.
- **RESPECT:** Students are expected to respect their teachers, respect their chaperones, respect the staff and respect other visitors. Teachers/chaperones are expected to assist the staff with enforcing this rule.
